

Safety

Installation

Can be installed and operated in any orientation except permanently inverted.

Handles

Batteries must not be suspended by their handles (where fitted). **Vent valves**

Each cell is fitted with a low pressure release valve to allow gasses to escape and then reseal.

Gas release

VRLA batteries release hydrogen gas which can form explosive mixtures in the air. Do not place inside a sealed container.
